The Stratford Basketball Association Inc. wishes to advise all teams, captains and players wishing to participate in our competitions and leagues, of their obligations to do duties throughout the entire season that they participate. Entries close 27th October 2023. Summer league will start approximately at the start of November 2023. There is usually a break over Christmas, and then the league finishes approximately February 2024. (This will be confirmed once team entry numbers are in).

Duties required are:-

1. REFEREEING DUTIES

As stipulated in the draws when your team is on duty or as per direction of the committee or any of its members. We will be having some allocated paid referees to help with summer league this season. You may still have to referee when on duty so please read your draw carefully.

2. SCOREBENCH DUTIES

Two/three people must operate the bench. The team benches and game equipment must be set up and packed away, score bench areas cleaned after use and the official score sheet recording of games kept. Duty teams must arrive at the hall 15 minutes before the first game. Duty teams will play their game at 6.00pm then do duty for the rest of the night. Duty Teams to be vigilant with timing between games to ensure games don't run too late. The Fill In team will do duty for the first game and then play their game after at 6.45pm. Fill In team please be at hall by 5.50pm to ensure games start on time.

3. LEAGUE RULES

The Stratford Basketball Association runs the Summer League as social competition. There are no points tallied for winners or losers and unsporting and irresponsible behaviour will not be tolerated.

There must be a minimum of two women per team on court at all times. If all women in the team are fouled out of the game the men must continue to play with three male players. If younger players wish to play in the Summer League they must be in their Year 8 of Primary school and heading into High School in the New Year. (Unless permission has been obtained by the Committee prior to play).

4. PAYMENT OF TEAM SUB

Payment must be done as from the first day of play for any season or league. Your team sub must be paid to the Floor Controller or direct into the SBA bank account before your team's second game of the season. One complete team sub must be paid by that game or the game will be defaulted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If the team sub is not paid by the 3rd week of the draw, the team captains and players will be stood down.

Mixed Team Sub = \$ 500.00 - (Bank account for entry fee 15 3947 0142435 00)

5. DEFAULT GAMES NOTIFICATION

Must be carried out as per instruction in the front of the draw. Early notification allows time to reorganise playing schedules if needed.

6. CAPTAINS ROLES

The Captains role is that the committee ultimately holds them responsible for their teams actions. Be sure to choose members in your teams who will behave, pull their weight, comply with rules and regulations, and pay their fees so to ensure that (the captain) will play a full season. Captains will be penalised for the actions of their teams, so if you want to play choose wisely. Team Captains will also be responsible for Floor Controlling on the night of their team's duty.

7. REFEREE CLINIC

A minimum of 2 people may be required to attend a referee's clinic. Also please let a committee member know if you have anyone interested in furthering their refereeing.

8. UNIFORMS

Correct team uniforms to be worn from commencement of league. No pockets in shorts & undershirts to be same colour as team singlet as per BBNZ regulations. Players will be stood down if they do not comply with rules.
